Experiments Controlled studies manipulating one or more variables to determine their effect on an outcome variable Example Testing the impact of a new educational program on student achievement Howto Randomly assign participants to different groups control and experimental manipulate the independent variable and measure the dependent variable Use statistical tests to determine the significance of the results
