and mystical writings medieval art poetry and music

this book claims that paradise lost contains all the traits of the great epics as well as the predominant characteristics of early modern novels and that every history of the novel should acknowledge milton s unintentional contribution to the development of the genre milton s satan is presented as a novelistic character par excellence preceding memorable literary characters of novelistic provenance like dostoyevsky s raskolnikov shelley s monster or kafka s beetle in addition this book proves that all the elements of modernity like capitalism science all pervasive doubt the absence of unquestionable ideals radical individualism and the insatiable desire for self realization and incessant advancement are inherent to both paradise lost and satan s character just like a fully developed novelistic character and unlike any epic character in history satan constantly surprises us by failing exceeding or simply contradicting our expectations as such the book demonstrates that satan shares more common points with the likes of tom jones moll flanders or lovelace than with the traditional epic heroes like achilles or aeneas proving that the novel as a genre owes an immense debt to milton s grand epic and that satan may be perceived as a precursor of the great novelistic characters

in so doing they shed new light on both the private and public dimensions of western culture this second edition includes a substantial new preface relating the book to changing views of life after death in the new century book jacket

luther and his followers taught prayer in many different ways they used catechisms and catechesis to teach the basics of christian belief including the lord s prayer they emphasized understanding the petitions of prayer not just reciting words they encouraged the use of the psalms as prayers and produced literature designed to make the psalms accessible and understandable they published prayerbooks to instruct in prayer and offer prayers for a variety of vocations and situations lutheran sermons taught prayer both on particular occasions and on many sundays of the church year worship taught prayer and provided models for prayer literature for those suffering sickness death plague childbirth and war taught prayer as part of its effort to console literature for theological students and manuals designed to help pastors in their ministries contained instruction in prayer highlighting the importance of prayer in the life and ministry of the pastor and helping them to teach prayer this book gives a comprehensive overview of the theological underpinnings for prayer as well as the strategies and literature used by luther and his followers as they taught prayer to all people

in a companion to jesuit mysticism robert a maryks provides thirteen unique essays discussing the jesuit mystical tradition a somewhat neglected aspect of jesuit historiography that stretches as far back as the order s co founder ignatius of loyola his spiritual visions at manresa and ultimately the mystical perspective contained in his spiritual exercises the volume s contributions on the most significant representatives of the jesuit mystical tradition from baltasar Álvarez to louis lallemant to hugo makibi enomiya lassalle aim to fill this lacuna in jesuit historiography although intended primarily as a handbook for scholars seeking to further their own research in this area the volume will undoubtedly be of interest to scholars and students of jesuit studies more broadly

embracing the viewpoints of catholic protestant or orthodox thinkers of conservatives liberals radicals and agnostics christianity today is anything but monolithic or univocal in the oxford companion to christian thought general editor adrian hastings has tried to capture a sense of the great diversity of opinion that swirls about under the heading of christian thought indeed the 260 contributors who hail from twenty countries represent as wide a range of perspectives as possible here is a comprehensive and authoritative though not dogmatic overview of the full spectrum of christian thinking within its 600 alphabetically arranged entries readers will find lengthy survey articles on the history of christian thought on national and regional traditions and on various denominations from anglican to unitarian there is ample coverage of eastern thought as well examining the christian tradition in china japan india and africa the contributors examine major theological topics such as resurrection the eucharist and grace as well as controversial issues such as homosexuality and abortion in addition short entries illuminate symbols such as water and wine and there are many profiles of leading theologians of non christians who have deeply influenced christian
