- Simple Sentence** One independent clause The dog barked
- Compound Sentence** Two or more independent clauses joined by a coordinating conjunction eg and but or The dog barked and the cat hissed
- Complex Sentence** One independent clause and one or more dependent clauses The dog barked because it was scared
- CompoundComplex Sentence** Two or more independent clauses and one or more dependent clauses The dog barked because it was scared and the cat hissed at it
