claw concerns an underprivileged young man watching his so called superiors ursula is howard barker s typically intriguing take on the legend of st ursula he stumbled is a fable concerning an anatomist and a dying king and in the love of a good man we witness the mass burial of the dead

this contemporary translation from the french play is a a meticulous study of human relationships and of the power of contract and rhetoric first performed at london s the national theatre

based on a cult thriller also well known as a film
