Simon's analyses focus on economic relations such as sharecropping house contract sales debt peonage criminal surety and convict lease. She demonstrates how the music reflects this exploitative economic history and how it is shaped by commodification under racialized capitalism as Simon assesses the lyrics, technique and styles of a wide range of blues musicians including Bessie Smith, Blind Lemon Jefferson, Big Bill Broonzy, Muddy Waters, B.B. King, Albert Collins and Kirk Fletcher. She argues forcefully that the call for racial justice is at the heart of the blues. A highly sophisticated interpretation of the blues tradition steeped in musicology, social history and critical cultural hermeneutics, debt and redemption not only clarifies blues as an aesthetic tradition but more importantly proves that it advances a theory of social and economic development and change.
