in this book Studebaker develops a theory of legitimacy to explain the crisis of liberal democracy in established democracies like the United Kingdom and the United States in these countries there is deep dissatisfaction with political procedures yet no credible alternatives have emerged without alternatives the crisis cannot produce revolution instead Studebaker suggests that the disagreements that ordinarily lead to political violence instead proliferate throughout the state and society as the distinction between legitimacy and ideology blurs efforts to generate legitimacy instead generate greater inequality pluralism and gridlock as different factions try to save democracy in radically different ways diverse advocates of democracy get in each other's way and even begin to appear authoritarian to one another in legitimacy in liberal democracies Studebaker depicts a legitimacy crisis rife with state capacity problems in which citizens tell each other many conflicting legitimization stories as they search for ways to live with a dissatisfying political system they cannot replace the result is a legitimization hydra a state that is burdened by an excess of narratives that struggles to take any

action at all

pasi ihalainen s book demonstrates that political pluralism was generally conceptualised through terminology derived from the traditionally dominant religious discourse which contributed to continuity in critical attitudes towards political parties yet significant shifts also occurred in the application of religious terminology of pluralism these shifts include the gradual secularisation of the vocabularies of the political and of party there also occurred a decline in the frequency of religious terms as politics and religion became understood as separate though analogous spheres terminologies of religious and political pluralism became more distinct which facilitated the expression of more positive attitudes towards political pluralism

in this study author tapani turkka offers a discussion of the origins of parliamentarism in the context of early 18th century britain this is accomplished through the author s personal interpretation of john locke s political thought in the second treatise in this interpretation the exercise of state power is not political by nature but must be separately constituted as such according to dr turkka locke finds this possible with his contemporaries and succeeding generations of men it is argued that this took place without a precedent during sir robert walpole s long ascendancy 1721 1742 and due to his innovative policies samuel sandys motion in 1741 to remove walpole from his office as prime minister embodies in compact form the problems involved in the use of state power constituted as political as such the book allows a concentrated study of the origins of parliamentarism

william blackstone used lockean philosophy to reshape the common law and how the americans of the eighteenth century used lockean philosophy to reshape whig political thought zuckert argues that locke s philosophy has continuing philosophic and political force a proposition he demonstrates by arguing that locke presents a form of political philosophy superior to that of the liberal theorists of our day and that he has solid rejoinders to contemporary critics of liberalism
